
which they were all awarded Jamaica's fifth highest national honour – the Order of Jamaica (O.J.).

Creating three Foundations with similar objectives and *raison de etre* would be superfluous to honour these three Jamaican priests. Accordingly, the rationale for including Archbishops Lawrence A. Burke S.J. and Donald J. Reece in the "Brand" Carter Foundation is to continue the legacy that the "Ignatian and Franciscan Spirit" had developed in each of them to touch, transform and change lives through teaching, sanctifying, and healing. The men and women who become recipients of Fellowships from the Carter Foundation will be expected to be catalysts for social change by transforming their lives and those of young people they encounter through early childhood education and beyond.
